### It's All About the Bass!

CUMC is blessed to have multiple sets of handbells and handchimes, which have been purchased using raised and donated funds over the course of 30+ years. Our latest purchases are our low bass chimes.

These large chimes are positioned on a special rack and are rung from that rack with large, soft mallets. They are not loud in volume but they add a wonderful depth of sound to a handbell piece, much like the low pedal pipes on the organ.

There are 12 chimes from C2 through B2 that we hope to purchase. So far, through Handbell Dessert Concert proceeds and generous donations, we have 8. So far the chimes have been used both in concert and worship and Jubilation will use them in their prelude on October 14.
