Born at Fort Shapiro in Chitose, Japan, John experienced the childhood of a military family, moving to California, Massachusetts, Arizona, Ohio, and finally Maryland, where he graduated from Laurel High School in 1977. His lifelong love of storytelling led him to a 1981 BA degree in Radio/TV/Film Studies from the University of Maryland. After graduation he worked in Army Intelligence until 1990, stationed first in Germany which at points involved watching East German forces on the other side of the Berlin Wall, and later at the Presidio in San Francisco. He moved from the military to the U.S. Department of State, focusing on programming and computer science applications. This later brought him to the commercial sector where he worked on applications and projects for several companies, ending his career at the University of Maryland as a trainer for campus staff in business applications. His encyclopedic knowledge of film and sports history always served him well, as did his facility with Civil War history which he put to use in 2017-19 as a volunteer Park Ranger at the Manassas Battlefield Park.
