History of CUMC's pipe organ

- Contract signed with M.P. Moller Organ Co. of Hagerstown, MD, in 1987
- Opus 11,791
- 1,930 pipes plus 12 chimes
- Purchase price - \$250,000
- Rev. Robert Parsons, the senior pastor, personally requested the trumpet enchanade because he had heard and admired one at a nearby United Methodist Church.
- The Positif and Pedal divisions are located to the left of the center of the sanctuary.
- The Swell and Great divisions are located to the right of the center of the sanctuary.
- The façade pipes (the ones that you can see at the front of the sanctuary) are from the Pedal Principal 16.
- Construction began on the current church building in 1991.
- The organ was installed after the building was completed.
- At the first service in February, 1992, the organ was only partially installed.
- Installation and voicing were completed by the end of March, 1992.
- M.P. Moller closed its doors after over 100 year of organ building in April, 1992.
- Our organ was one of the last original 3-manual instruments to leave their factory.
