

CUMC Summer 2026 Intern

Who: Someone who may be discerning the call to ordained ministry or a church profession, and who is a high school graduate, college student or young adult. The successful candidate may also be considering a career in social services or other helping professions.

Desired Candidates: A Centreville UMC member/attender is preferred, but outside candidates will also be considered.

Duration: 6-8 weeks total over the summer months, late May – early August. A 6 to 8-week period during that timeframe will be mutually agreed upon based on the successful candidate's and church's calendars.

Supervision: The intern will report to Deacon Phil Mohr and will be assigned to various ministry areas throughout the summer.

Scenario: The intern will actively rotate among ministries of the church each week. Assignments will line up with events like music camp, Vacation Bible School, mission trips, etc. This program is intended to expose the intern to a broad range of ministry opportunities and settings while also supporting the church in its summer ministries. Regular check-in meetings with Deacon Phil will be held to debrief ministry experiences and discern vocation and call.

Compensation: \$500 per week. Schedule depends on events at the church in the summer. Some evening and weekend work will be required and coordinated with the intern. Deacon Phil will coordinate with the various ministries to establish a schedule for the intern. Estimated compensation will be \$3,000-\$4000, depending on the length of the internship.

Selection process: Interested persons should submit a cover letter and resume to Deacon Phil no later than April 30, 2026 at pmohr@centreville-umc.org. In the cover letter please highlight your motivation and qualifications to be our CUMC summer intern.

Post internship: An evaluation of the process and experience will be conducted by the supervisor and intern at the end of the internship.
